GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION AT CLUB/DISTRICT LEVEL

TEAM AND SIDES SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection Criteria may include the following:

- . Performance in Club/District titles;
- . Performance in previous Club and District Representation;
- . Demonstrate and/or potential ability to work with other players and team officials i.e team player:
- . Demonstrate attitude and commitment to Club or District regarding representation;
- . The player's ability to play in the expected conditions and take instructions:
- . Player's flexibility to perform against diverse competition and players of differing styles and venue conditions;
- . Competitive ability of players;
- . Behaviour on and off the bowling green;
- . Personal presentation;
- . Leadership qualities;
- . Player's ability to represent their Club or District with dignity;
- . Ability to enjoy and benefit from the experience:

SUGGESTED CRITERIA FOR SELECTORS

- . The ability to make impartial judgments
- . Knowledge of the sport
- . Communication skills with other selectors and players
- . An open minded attitude

- . Honesty and integrity
- . Don't play together – spread yourselves around - especially before making selections
- . Be aware, of the playing ability of players.
- . Don't continually select yourself in the best teams.
